Submissions must be in English, must use the Seventh Edition of the *MLA Style Manual and Guide in Scholarly Publishing* in text, notes, and bibliography, and must be no longer than 40,000 characters maximum (including spaces, notes, and bibliography). These must be accompanied by a 200-word abstract and a separate cover sheet bearing the author's name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, and affiliation. Submissions are double-blind peer reviewed; the author's name should not appear anywhere in the manuscript. *RSA* reviews submissions with the understanding that they have not been submitted concurrently to another journal.
